- And the people kept standing at a distance, but Moses went near to the dark cloud mass where the true God was. (Exodus 20:21)
- At that time Solomon said; Yehowah himself said he was to reside in the thick gloom. (1 Kings 8:12)
- He then made darkness his concealment place, all around him as his booth, dark waters, thick clouds. (Psalms 18:11)
