- And he proceeded to bend the heavens down and to descend, and **thick gloom** was beneath his feet. (**2 Samuel 22:10**)

- It was then that Solomon said; Yehowah himself said he was to reside in the **thick gloom**. (**2 Chronicles 6:1**)
- Enclosing the face of the **throne**, spreading out over it his cloud. (**Job 26:9**)
