YEHOWAH - GOD IS A REVEALER OF SECRETS, A LORD OF LORDS

Daniel 2:47... The king was answering Daniel and saying; Truly the God of you men is a God of gods and a Lord of kings and a Revealer of secrets, because you were able to reveal this secret.

[23] - References

- SEE now that I, I am He, and there are no gods together with me. I put to death, and I make alive. I have severely wounded, and I, I will heal, and there is no one snatching out of my hand. (Deuteronomy 32:39)
- Give thanks to the God of the gods, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:2)
- And the king will actually do according to his own will, and he will exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and against the God of gods he will speak marvelous things. And he will certainly prove successful until the denunciation will have come to a finish, because the thing decided upon must be done. (Daniel 11:36)
- For even though there are those who are called gods, whether in heaven or on earth, just as there are many gods and many lords. (1 Corinthians 8:5)
- For Yehowah YOUR God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the God great, mighty and fear-inspiring, who treats none with partiality nor accepts a bribe. (Deuteronomy 10:17)
- Give thanks to the Lord of the lords, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:3)
- After that Pharaoh said to Joseph; Since God has caused you to know all this, there is no one as discreet and wise as you are. (Genesis 41:39)
- And as for these children, the four of them, to them the true God gave knowledge and insight in all writing and wisdom, and Daniel

himself had understanding in all sorts of visions and dreams. (Daniel 1:17)

- However, there exists a God in the heavens who is a Revealer of secrets, and he has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what is to occur in the final part of the days. Your dream and the visions of your head upon your bed, this it is. (Daniel 2:28)
- O Belteshazzar the chief of the magic-practicing priests, because I myself well know that the spirit of the holy gods is in you and that there is no secret at all that is troubling you, tell me the visions of my dream that I have beheld and its interpretation. (Daniel 4:9)
- For the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will not do a thing unless he has revealed his confidential matter to his servants the prophets. (Amos 3:7)
- Now I do know that Yehowah is greater than all the other gods by reason of this affair in which they acted presumptuously against them. (Exodus 18:11)
- For their rock is not like our Rock, even our enemies being the ones to decide. (Deuteronomy 32:31)
- At this Joash said to all those who stood against him; Will you be the ones to make a legal defense for Baal to see whether you yourselves may save him? Whoever makes a legal defense for him ought to be put to death even this morning. If he is God, let him make a legal defense for himself, because someone has pulled down his altar. (Judges 6:31)
- Let it become known to the king that we went to the jurisdictional district of Judah to the house of the great God, and it is being built with stones rolled into place, and timbers are being laid in the walls, and that work is being eagerly done and is making progress in their hands. (Ezra 5:8)
- Inasmuch as from before the king and his seven counselors an order was sent to investigate concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the Law of your God that is in your hand. (Ezra 7:14)
- I will exalt you, O my God the King, and I will bless your name to time indefinite, even forever. (Psalms 145:1)
- But the thing that the king himself is asking is difficult, and nobody else exists who can show it before the king except the gods, whose own dwelling does not exist with flesh at all. (Daniel 2:11)

- And as for me, it is not through any wisdom that exists in me more than in any others alive that this secret is revealed to me, except to the intent that the interpretation may be made known to the king himself and that the thoughts of your heart you may know. (Daniel 2:30)
- Then it was that Nebuchadnezzar approached the door of the burning fiery furnace. He was answering and saying; Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, you servants of the Most High God, step out and come here! At that time Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego were stepping out from the midst of the fire. (Daniel 3:26)
- Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying; Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who sent his angel and rescued his servants that trusted in him and that changed the very word of the king and gave over their bodies, because they would not serve and would not worship any god at all except their own God. (Daniel 3:28)
- There exists a capable man in your kingdom in whom there is the spirit of holy gods, and in the days of your father illumination and insight and wisdom like the wisdom of gods were found in him, and King Nebuchadnezzar your father himself set him up as chief of the magic-practicing priests, the conjurers, the Chaldeans and the astrologers, even your father, O king. (Daniel 5:11)
- The secrets of his heart become manifest, so that he will fall upon his face and worship God, declaring; God is really among YOU. (1 Corinthians 14:25)
