Psalms 132:13... For Yehowah has chosen Zion, he has longed for it as a dwelling for himself.

[28] - References

- Make melody, you people, to Yehowah, who is dwelling in Zion, tell among the peoples his deeds. (Psalms 9:11)
- In her dwelling towers God himself has become known as a secure height. (Psalms 48:3)
- Remember your assembly that you acquired long ago, the tribe that you redeemed as your inheritance, this Mount Zion in which you have resided. (Psalms 74:2)
- And his covert proves to be in Salem itself, and his dwelling place in Zion. (Psalms 76:2)
- But he chose the tribe of Judah, mount Zion, which he loved. (Psalms 78:68)
- Blessed out of Zion be Yehowah, who is residing in Jerusalem. Praise Yah, you people! (Psalms 135:21)
- But You have approached a Mount Zion and a city of the living God, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (Hebrews 12:22)
- Yehowah is more in love with the gates of Zion than with all the tabernacles of Jacob. (Psalms 87:2)
- And I shall indeed reside in the middle of the sons of Israel, and I shall not leave my people Israel. (1 Kings 6:13)
- In case your people go out to the war against their enemy in the way that you send them, and they indeed pray to Yehowah in the direction of the city that you have chosen and the house that I have built to your name. (1 Kings 8:44)

- And Yehowah went on to say to him; I have heard your prayer and your request for favor with which you requested favor before me. I have sanctified this house that you have built by putting my name there to time indefinite, and my eyes and my heart will certainly prove to be there always. (1 Kings 9:3)
- And the one tribe is what will continue his for the sake of my servant David and for the sake of Jerusalem, the city that I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel. (1 Kings 11:32)
- As for Rehoboam the son of Solomon, he had become king in Judah. Forty-one years old Rehoboam was when he began to reign, and seventeen years he reigned in Jerusalem, the city that Yehowah had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel to put his name there. And his mother's name was Naamah the Ammonitess. (1 Kings 14:21)
- And he built altars in the house of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem I shall put my name. (2 Kings 21:4)
- Now do not stiffen YOUR neck as YOUR forefathers did. Give place to Yehowah and come to his sanctuary that he has sanctified to time indefinite and serve Yehowah YOUR God, that his burning anger may turn back from YOU. (2 Chronicles 30:8)
- And they went on speaking against the God of Jerusalem the same way as against the gods of the peoples of the earth, the work of man's hands. (2 Chronicles 32:19)
- When you will have returned to me and kept my commandments and done them, though your dispersed people should happen to be at the end of the heavens, from there I shall collect them and certainly bring them to the place that I have chosen to have my name reside there. (Nehemiah 1:9)
- O my God, within me my very soul is in despair. That is why I remember you, from the land of Jordan and the peaks of Hermon, from the little mountain. (Psalms 42:6)
- God is in the midst of the city, it will not be made to totter. God will help it at the appearance of morning. (Psalms 46:5)
- Why do You, O You mountains of peaks, keep watching enviously the mountain that God has desired for himself to dwell in? Even Yehowah himself will reside there forever. (Psalms 68:16)
- Jerusalem is one that is built like a city that has been joined together in oneness. (Psalms 122:3)

- It is yet day in Nob to make a halt. He waves his hand threateningly at the mountain of the daughter of Zion, the hill of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 10:32)
- And what will anyone say in answer to the messengers of the nation? That Yehowah himself has laid the foundation of Zion, and in her the afflicted ones of his people will take refuge. (Isaiah 14:32)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to me; I will keep undisturbed and look upon my established place, like the dazzling heat along with the light, like the cloud of dew in the heat of harvest. (Isaiah 18:4)
- And the full moon has become abashed, and the glowing sun has become ashamed, for Yehowah of armies has become king in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem and in front of his elderly men with glory. (Isaiah 24:23)
- For the hand of Yehowah will settle down on this mountain, and Moab must be trodden down in its place as when a straw heap is trodden down in a manure place. (Isaiah 25:10)
- Behold Zion, the town of our festal occasions! Your own eyes will see Jerusalem an undisturbed abiding place, a tent that no one will pack up. Never will its tent pins be pulled out, and none of its ropes will be torn in two. (Isaiah 33:20)
- Call out further, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; My cities will yet overflow with goodness, and Yehowah will yet certainly feel regrets over Zion and yet actually choose Jerusalem. (Zechariah 1:17)
