- Because my eyes have seen your means of saving. (Luke 2:30)
- And Yehowah of armies will become high through judgment, and the true God, the Holy One, will certainly sanctify himself through righteousness. (Isaiah 5:16)
- And nations will certainly go to your light, and kings to the brightness of your shining forth. (Isaiah 60:3)
- And the nations will certainly see your righteousness, O woman, and all kings your glory. And you will actually be called by a new name, which the very mouth of Yehowah will designate. (Isaiah 62:2)
