Isaiah 25:8•• He will actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it.

^[17] - References

- And he **will wipe** out every tear from their eyes, and **death will** be no more, neither **will** mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away. (**Revelation 21:4**)
- And the very ones redeemed by **Yehowah will** return and **certainly** come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite **will** be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they **will** attain, and grief and sighing must flee **away**. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, **will** shepherd them, and **will** guide them to fountains of waters of life. And God **will wipe** out every tear from their eyes. (**Revelation 7:17**)
- And **death** and Hades were hurled into the lake of fire. This means the second **death**, the lake of fire. (**Revelation 20:14**)
- For sheer zeal for your house **has** eaten me up, and the very reproaches of those reproaching you have fallen upon me. (**Psalms 69:9**)
- How your enemies have reproached, O **Yehowah**, how they have reproached the footprints of your anointed one. (**Psalms 89:51**)
- But when this which is corruptible puts on incorruption and this which is mortal puts on immortality, then the saying **will take** place that is written: Death is swallowed up forever. (**1 Corinthians 15:54**)
- Death, where is your victory? Death, where is your sting? (**1 Corinthians 15:55**)

- The sting producing **death** is sin, but the power for sin is the Law. (1 Corinthians 15:56)

- But thanks to God, for he gives us the victory through our **Lord** Jesus Christ! (1 Corinthians 15:57)

- But now it **has** been made clearly evident through the manifestation of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who **has** abolished **death** but **has** shed light upon life and incorruption through the Good News. (2 Timothy 1:10)

- And that he might emancipate all those who for fear of **death** were subject to slavery all through their lives. (Hebrews 2:15)

- Your dead ones **will** live. A corpse of mine, they **will** rise up. Awake and cry out joyfully, **you** residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the **earth** itself **will** let even those impotent in **death** drop in birth. (Isaiah 26:19)

- Then the redeemed ones of **Yehowah** themselves **will** return and must come to Zion with a joyful outcry, and rejoicing to time indefinite **will** be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they **will** attain. Grief and sighing **will certainly** flee **away**. (Isaiah 51:11)

- No more **will** your sun set, nor **will** your moon go on the wane, for **Yehowah** himself **will** become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your mourning **will** have come to completion. (Isaiah 60:20)

- To proclaim the year of goodwill on the part of **Yehowah** and the day of vengeance on the part of our God, to comfort all the mourning ones. (Isaiah 61:2)

- And I **will** be joyful in Jerusalem and exult in my **people**, and no more **will** there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (Isaiah 65:19)

- From the hand of Sheol I shall redeem them, from **death** I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O Sheol? Compassion itself **will** be concealed from my eyes. (Hosea 13:14)

- Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs **will** hear his voice (John 5:28)
