Isaiah 25:8" He will actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah will certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it.

- And he will wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death will be no more, neither will mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away. (Revelation 21:4)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah will return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (Isaiah 35:10)
- Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, will shepherd them, and will guide them to fountains of waters of life. And God will wipe out every tear from their eyes. (Revelation 7:17)
- And death and Hades were hurled into the lake of fire. This means the second death, the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:14)
- For sheer zeal for your house has eaten me up, and the very reproaches of those reproaching you have fallen upon me. (Psalms 69:9)
- How your enemies have reproached, O Yehowah, how they have reproached the footprints of your anointed one. (Psalms 89:51)
- But when this which is corruptible puts on incorruption and this which is mortal puts on immortality, then the saying will take place that is written: Death is swallowed up forever. (1 Corinthians 15:54)
- Death, where is your victory? Death, where is your sting? (1 Corinthians 15:55)

- The sting producing death is sin, but the power for sin is the Law. (1 Corinthians 15:56)
- But thanks to God, for he gives us the victory through our Lord
 Jesus Christ! (1 Corinthians 15:57)
- But now it has been made clearly evident through the manifestation of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has abolished death but has shed light upon life and incorruption through the Good News. (2 Timothy 1:10)
- And that he might emancipate all those who for fear of death were subject to slavery all through their lives. (Hebrews 2:15)
- Your dead ones will live. A corpse of mine, they will rise up. Awake and cry out joyfully, you residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the earth itself will let even those impotent in death drop in birth. (Isaiah 26:19)
- Then the redeemed ones of Yehowah themselves will return and must come to Zion with a joyful outcry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain. Grief and sighing will certainly flee away. (Isaiah 51:11)

- From the hand of Sheol I shall redeem them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O Sheol? Compassion itself will be concealed from my eyes. (Hosea 13:14)
