Isaiah 42:13· Like a mighty man Yehowah himself will go forth. Like a warrior he will awaken zeal. He will shout, yes, he will let out a war cry, over his enemies he will show himself mightier.

- And he went striking down his adversaries from behind, a reproach of indefinite duration he gave to them. (**Psalms 78:66**)
- Then he put on righteousness as a coat of mail, and the helmet of salvation upon his head. Furthermore, he put on the garments of vengeance as raiment and enwrapped himself with **zeal** as if a sleeveless coat. (**Isaiah 59:17**)
- And as for you, you **will** prophesy to them all these words, and you must say to them; From on high **Yehowah** himself **will** roar, and from his holy dwelling he **will** give forth his voice. Without fail he **will** roar upon his abiding place. A **shout** like that of those treading the winepress he **will** sing **out** against all the inhabitants of the earth. (**Jeremiah 25:30**)
- **Yehowah** is a manly person of **war**. **Yehowah** is his name. (**Exodus 15:3**)
- **Yehowah** is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, **Yehowah** is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. **Yehowah** is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his **enemies**. (**Nahum 1:2**)
- After **Yehowah** they **will** walk. Like a lion he **will** roar, for he himself **will** roar, and sons **will** come trembling from the west. (**Hosea 11:10**)
- And **out** of Zion **Yehowah** himself **will** roar, and **out** of Jerusalem he **will** give forth his voice. And heaven and earth certainly **will** rock,

but **Yehowah will** be a refuge for his people, and a fortress for the sons of Israel. (**Joel 3:16**)

- **SEE** now that I, I am He, and there are no gods together with me. I put to death, and I make alive. I have severely wounded, and I, I **will** heal, and there is no one snatching **out** of my hand. (**Deuteronomy 32:39**)

- As for **Yehowah**, those contending against him **will** be terrified, Against them he **will** thunder in the heavens. **Yehowah** himself **will** judge the ends of the earth, that he may give strength to his king, that he may exalt the horn of his anointed one. (**1 Samuel 2:10**)

- And no day has proved to be like that one, either before it or after it, in that **Yehowah** listened to the voice of a **man**, for **Yehowah** himself was fighting for Israel. (**Joshua 10:14**)

- Who, then, is this glorious King? **Yehowah** strong and mighty, **Yehowah** mighty in battle. (**Psalms 24:8**)

- Take hold of buckler and large shield, and do rise up in assistance of me. (**Psalms 35:2**)

- Our God **will** come and cannot possibly keep silent. Before him there devours a fire, and all around him it has become exceedingly stormy weather. (**Psalms 50:3**)

- Then **Yehowah** began to awake as from sleeping, like a mighty one sobering up from wine. (**Psalms 78:65**)

- Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh do rouse up your mightiness, and do come to our salvation. (**Psalms 80:2**)

- For this is what **Yehowah** has said to me; Just as the lion growls, even the maned young lion, over its prey, when there is called **out** against it a full number of shepherds, and in spite of their voice he **will** not be terrified and in spite of their commotion he **will** not stoop, in the same way **Yehowah** of armies **will** come down to wage **war** over Mount Zion and over her hill. (**Isaiah 31:4**)

- And **Yehowah** himself **will** certainly give forth his voice before his military force, for his camp is very numerous. For he who is carrying **out** his word is mighty, for the day of **Yehowah** is great and very fear-inspiring, and who can hold up under it? (**Joel 2:11**)

- The one making a breakthrough **will** certainly come up before them, they **will** actually break through. And they **will** pass through a

gate, and they **will go out** by it. And their king **will** pass through before them, with **Yehowah** at the head of them. (**Micah 2:13**)

· Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour **out** upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my **zeal** all the earth **will** be devoured.
