- Why have the nations been in tumult and the national groups themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (**Psalms 2:1**)
- The kings of earth take their stand and **high** officials themselves have massed together as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (**Psalms 2:2**)
- Saying; Let us tear their bands apart and cast their cords away from us! (**Psalms 2:3**)
- The very One sitting in the heavens **will** laugh, Yehowah himself **will** hold them in derision. (**Psalms 2:4**)
- At that time he **will** speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he **will** disturb them. (**Psalms 2:5**)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
- Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah, he **has** said to me You are my son, I, today, I have **become** your father. (**Psalms 2:7**)
- Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the earth as your **own** possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)
- You **will** break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you **will** dash them to pieces. (**Psalms 2:9**)
- And now, O kings, exercise insight, let yourselves be corrected, O judges of the earth. (**Psalms 2:10**)

- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (**Psalms 2:11**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not **become** incensed and **you** may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- The utterance of Yehowah to my Lord is; Sit at my right **hand** until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet. (**Psalms 110:1**)
- The rod of your strength Yehowah **will** send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (**Psalms 110:2**)
- Your **people will** offer themselves willingly on the day of your military force. In the splendors of holiness, from the womb of the dawn, you have your company of young men just like dewdrops. (**Psalms 110:3**)
- Yehowah **has** bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the nations, and all the ends of the earth must see the salvation of our God. (**Isaiah 52:10**)
- Who **has** put faith in the thing heard by us? And as for the arm of Yehowah, to whom **has** it been revealed? (**Isaiah 53:1**)
- But on being asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God was coming, he answered them and said; The kingdom of God is not coming with striking observableness. (**Luke 17:20**)
- For just as the days of Noah were, so the presence of the Son of man **will** be. (**Matthew 24:37**)
- For as they were in those days before the flood, eating and drinking, men marrying and women being given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark. (**Matthew 24:38**)
- And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man **will** be. (**Matthew 24:39**)
- Do arise, O Yehowah. O God, lift up your **hand**. Do not forget the afflicted ones. (**Psalms 10:12**)
- Your **hand will** be **high** above your **adversaries**, and all enemies of yours **will** be cut off. (**Micah 5:9**)
- And he went on to say; Go, and you must say to this **people**, Hear again and again, O men, but do not understand, and see again and again, but do not get any knowledge. (**Isaiah 6:9**)

- Work out with me a sign meaning goodness, that those hating me may see it and be **ashamed**. For you yourself, O Yehowah, have helped me and comforted me. (**Psalms 86:17**)
- Hold a good conscience, so that in the particular in which **you** are spoken against they may get **ashamed** who are speaking slightly of **YOUR** good conduct in connection with Christ. (**1 Peter 3:16**)
- Look! I **will** give those from the synagogue of Satan who say they are Jews, and yet they are not but are lying, look! I **will** make them come and do obeisance before your feet and make them know I have loved you. (**Revelation 3:9**)
- But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy that is going to consume those in opposition. (**Hebrews 10:27**)
- God himself **will** store up one's hurtfulness for one's **own** sons, he **will** reward him that he may know it. (**Job 21:19**)
- His ways keep prospering all the time. Your judicial decisions are **high** up out of his range, as for all those showing hostility to him, he puffs at them. (**Psalms 10:5**)
- Nations **will** see and **become ashamed** of all their mightiness. They **will** put their **hand** upon their mouth, their very ears **will become** deaf. (**Micah 7:16**)
- Here I am acting against all those afflicting you, at that time, and I **will** save her that is limping, and her that is dispersed I shall collect together. And I **will** set them as a praise and as a name in all the land of their shame. (**Zephaniah 3:19**)
