

YEHOWAH - YEHOWAH HAS SWORN TO DAVID AND HE WILL SEE TO IT

Psalms 132:11.. Yehowah has sworn to David, truly he will not draw back from it; Of the fruitage of your belly I shall set on your throne.

- So may God do to Abner and so may he add to it, if, just as Yehowah swore to **David**, that is not the way that I shall do to him. (**2 Samuel 3:9**)
- I have concluded a covenant toward my chosen one, I have **sworn** to **David** my servant. (**Psalms 89:3**)
- For there are indeed men that have become priests without a **sworn** oath, but there is one with an oath **sworn** by the One who said respecting him; Yehowah **has sworn**, and he **will** feel no regret, You are a priest forever. (**Hebrews 7:21**)
- And, besides, the Excellency of Israel **will** not prove false, and He **will** not feel regrets, for He is not an earthling man so as to feel regrets. (**1 Samuel 15:29**)
- Yehowah **has sworn**, and he **will** feel no regret; You are a priest to time indefinite according to the manner of Melchizedek! (**Psalms 110:4**)
- By my own self I have **sworn**, out of my own mouth in righteousness the word **has** gone forth, so that it **will** not return, that to me every knee **will** bend down, every tongue **will** swear. (**Isaiah 45:23**)
- So my word that goes forth from my mouth **will** prove to be. It **will** not return to me without results, but it **will** certainly do that in which I have delighted, and it **will** have certain success in that for which I have sent it. (**Isaiah 55:11**)
- Likewise could my own covenant be broken with **David** my servant so that he should not come to have a son ruling as king upon

his **throne**, also with the Levites, the priests, my ministers. (**Jeremiah 33:21**)

- When your days come to the full, and you must lie down with your forefathers, then I shall certainly raise up your seed after you, which **will** come out of your inward parts, and I shall indeed firmly establish his kingdom. (**2 Samuel 7:12**)

- And it must occur that when your days have come to the full for you to go to be with your forefathers, I shall certainly raise up your seed after you that **will** come to be one of your sons, and I shall indeed firmly establish his kingship. (**1 Chronicles 17:11**)

- And he **has** raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of **David** his servant. (**Luke 1:69**)

- From the offspring of this man according to his promise God **has** brought to Israel a savior, Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 13:23**)

- And now, O Yehowah the God of Israel, keep toward your servant **David** my father that which you promised him, saying; There **will** not be cut off a man of yours from before me to sit upon the **throne** of Israel, if only your sons **will** take care of their way by walking before me just as you have walked before me. (**1 Kings 8:25**)

- And I **will** cause him to stand in my house and in my kingship to time indefinite, and his **throne will** itself become one lasting to time indefinite. (**1 Chronicles 17:14**)

- And now, O Yehowah the God of Israel, keep toward your servant **David** my father what you promised him, saying; There **will** not be cut off a man of yours from before me to sit upon the **throne** of Israel, if only your sons **will** take care of their way by walking in my Law, just as you have walked before me. (**2 Chronicles 6:16**)

- His seed itself **will** prove to be even to time indefinite, and his **throne** as the sun in front of me. (**Psalms 89:36**)

- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there **will** be no end, upon the **throne** of **David** and upon his kingdom in order to establish it firmly and to sustain it by means of justice and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies **will** do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)

- As Jesus was passing along from there, two blind men followed him, crying out and saying; Have mercy on us, Son of David. (**Matthew 9:27**)

- Therefore, because he was a prophet and knew that God had **sworn** to him with an oath that he would seat one from the **fruitage** of his loins upon his **throne**. (**Acts of Apostles 2:30**)
- Concerning his Son, who sprang from the seed of **David** according to the flesh. (**Romans 1:3**)
- And again Isaiah says; There **will** be the root of Jesse, and there **will** be one arising to rule nations, on him nations **will** rest their hope. (**Romans 15:12**)
- And now, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, you are the true God, and as for your words, let them prove to be truth, since you promise to your servant this goodness. (**2 Samuel 7:28**)
- For is not my household like that with God? Because it is an indefinitely lasting covenant that he **has** assigned to me, nicely put in order in everything and secured. Because it is all my salvation and all my delight, is that not why he **will** make it grow? (**2 Samuel 23:5**)
- Go and enter in to King **David**, and you must say to him, Was it not you, my lord the king, that swore to your slave girl, saying; Solomon your son is the one that **will** become king after me, and he is the one that **will** sit upon my throne? So why **has** Adonijah become king? (**1 Kings 1:13**)
- And, besides, Solomon **has** sat down upon the **throne** of the kingship. (**1 Kings 1:46**)
- In order that Yehowah may carry out his word that he spoke respecting me, saying; If your sons **will** take care of their way by walking before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there **will** not be cut off a man of yours from sitting upon the **throne** of Israel. (**1 Kings 2:4**)
- Now, O Yehowah God, let your promise with **David** my father prove faithful, for you yourself have made me king over a people as numerous as the dust particles of the earth. (**2 Chronicles 1:9**)
- And Yehowah did not want to bring the house of **David** to ruin, for the sake of the covenant that he had concluded with **David**, and just as he had said he would give him and his sons a lamp always. (**2 Chronicles 21:7**)
- Once I have **sworn** in my holiness, to **David** I **will** not tell lies. (**Psalms 89:35**)

- Where are your former acts of loving-kindness, O Yehowah, about which you swore to **David** in your faithfulness? (**Psalms 89:49**)
- And it must occur in that day that there **will** be the root of Jesse that **will** be standing up as a signal for the peoples. To him even the nations **will** turn inquiringly, and his resting-place must become glorious. (**Isaiah 11:10**)
- There **will** also certainly enter in by the gates of this city kings with princes, sitting on the **throne** of **David**, riding in the chariot and upon horses, they and their princes, the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and this city **will** certainly be inhabited to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 17:25**)
- This one **will** be great and **will** be called Son of the Most High, and Yehowah God **will** give him the **throne** of **David** his father. (**Luke 1:32**)
- He now said to them; These are my words which I spoke to **you** while I was yet with **you**, that all the things written in the Law of Moses and in the Prophets and Psalms about me must be fulfilled. (**Luke 24:44**)
- Has not the Scripture said that the Christ is coming from the offspring of **David**, and from Bethlehem the village where **David** used to be? (**John 7:42**)
