Isaiah 25:4· For you have become a stronghold to the lowly one, a stronghold to the poor one in the distress that he has, a refuge from the rainstorm, a shade from the heat, when the blast of the tyrannical ones is like a rainstorm against a wall.

- God is for us a **refuge** and strength, a help that is readily to be found during distresses. (**Psalms 46:1**)
- Yehowah is guarding you. Yehowah is your **shade** on your right hand. (**Psalms 121:5**)
- By day the sun itself will not strike you, nor the moon by night. (**Psalms 121:6**)
- Yehowah himself will guard you **against** all calamity. He will guard your soul. (**Psalms 121:7**)
- Yehowah himself will guard your going out and your coming in from now on and to time indefinite. (**Psalms 121:8**)
- Yehowah is good, a **stronghold** in the day of **distress**. And he is cognizant of those seeking **refuge** in him. (**Nahum 1:7**)
- And I shall certainly let remain in the midst of you a people humble and **lowly**, and they will actually take **refuge** in the name of Yehowah. (**Zephaniah 3:12**)
- They will hunger no more nor thirst anymore, neither will the sun beat down upon them nor any scorching **heat**. (**Revelation 7:16**)
- Yehowah is guarding you. Yehowah is your **shade** on your right hand. (**Psalms 121:5**)

- And there will come to be a booth for a **shade** by day from the dry **heat**, and for a **refuge** and for a hiding place from the **rainstorm** and from the precipitation. (**Isaiah 4:6**)
- And I will deliver you out of the hand of the bad **ones**, and I will redeem you out of the palm of the **tyrannical ones**. (**Jeremiah 15:21**)
- O Yehowah my strength and my **stronghold**, and my place for flight in the day of **distress**, to you the nations themselves will come from the ends of the earth, and they will say; Indeed our forefathers came to possess sheer falsehood, vanity and things in which there was nothing beneficial. (**Jeremiah 16:19**)
- Say to those plastering with whitewash that it will fall. A flooding downpour will certainly occur, and **you**, O hailstones, will fall, and a **blast** of windstorms itself will cause a splitting. (**Ezekiel 13:11**)
- And that we may be delivered from harmful and wicked men, for faith is not a possession of all people. (**2 Thessalonians 3:2**)
