- God is for us a refuge and strength, a help that is readily to be found during distresses. (Psalms 46:1)
- Yehowah is guarding you. Yehowah is your shade on your right hand. (Psalms 121:5)
- By day the sun itself will not strike you, nor the moon by night.
  (Psalms 121:6)
- Yehowah himself will guard you against all calamity. He will guard your soul. (Psalms 121:7)
- Yehowah himself will guard your going out and your coming in from now on and to time indefinite. (Psalms 121:8)
- Yehowah is good, a stronghold in the day of distress. And he is cognizant of those seeking refuge in him. (Nahum 1:7)
