Psalms 102:13.. You yourself will arise, you will have mercy on Zion, for it is the season to be favorable to her, for the appointed time has come.

- In your goodwill do deal well with **Zion**, may you build the walls of Jerusalem. (**Psalms 51:18**)
- For God himself **will** save **Zion** and **will** build the cities of Judah, and they **will** certainly dwell there and take possession of it. (**Psalms 69:35**)
- Can a wife forget her suckling so that she should not pity the son of her belly? Even these women can forget, yet I myself shall not forget you. (**Isaiah 49:15**)
- And foreigners **will** actually build your walls, and their own kings **will** minister to you, for in my indignation I shall **have** struck you, but in my goodwill I shall certainly **have mercy** upon you. (**Isaiah 60:10**)
- And they **will** certainly **come** and cry out joyfully on the height of **Zion** and become radiant over the goodness of Yehowah, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (**Jeremiah 31:12**)
- Cry out loudly and rejoice, O daughter of **Zion**, for here I am coming, and I **will** reside in the midst of you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 2:10**)
- And in the first year of Cyrus the king of Persia, that Yehowah's word from the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, Yehowah roused the spirit of Cyrus the king of Persia so that he caused a cry to pass through all his realm, and also in writing, saying; (**Ezra 1:1**)
- **SPEAK** to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her that her military service **has** been fulfilled, that her error **has** been paid off. For

from the hand of Yehowah she **has** received a full amount for all her sins. (**Isaiah 40:2**)

- In the first year of his reigning I myself, Daniel, discerned by the books the number of the years concerning which the word of Yehowah had occurred to Jeremiah the prophet, for fulfilling the devastations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years. (**Daniel 9:2**)

- It is the time for Yehowah to act. They **have** broken your Law. (**Psalms 119:126**)

- And therefore Yehowah **will** keep in expectation of showing **you** favor, and therefore he **will** rise up to show **you** **mercy**. For Yehowah is a God of judgment. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 30:18**)

- For Yehowah **will** certainly comfort **Zion**. He **will** for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he **will** make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves **will** be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (**Isaiah 51:3**)

- For the sake of **Zion** I shall not keep still, and for the sake of Jerusalem I shall not stay quiet until her righteousness goes forth just like the brightness, and her salvation like a torch that burns. (**Isaiah 62:1**)

- For I shall bring up a recuperation for you, and from your strokes I shall heal you, is the utterance of Yehowah. For a woman chased away is what they called you; That is **Zion**, for whom no one is searching. (**Jeremiah 30:17**)

- Incline your ear, O my God, and hear. Do open your eyes and see our desolated conditions and the city that **has** been called by your name, for not according to our righteous acts are we letting our entreaties fall before you, but according to your many mercies. (**Daniel 9:18**)

- So the angel of Yehowah answered and said; O Yehowah of armies, how long **will** you yourself not show **mercy** to Jerusalem and to the cities of Judah, whom you **have** denounced these seventy years? (**Zechariah 1:12**)
