And they must rebuild the long-standing devastated places, they will raise up even the desolated places of former times, and they will certainly make anew the devastated cities, the places desolate for generation after generation.

[14] - References

- Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (Matthew 24:29)
- And then the sign of the Son of man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will beat themselves in lamentation, and they will see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (Matthew 24:30)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because you sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of you. (Genesis 45:5)
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there will be no plowing time or harvest. (Genesis 45:6)
- Consequently God sent me ahead of you in order to place a remnant for you men in the earth and to keep you alive by a great escape. (Genesis 45:7)
- And I prophesied just as I had been commanded. And a sound began to occur as soon as I prophesied, and here there was a rattling, and bones began to approach, bone to its bone. (Ezekiel 37:7)
- And I saw, and, look! Upon them sinews themselves and flesh itself came up and skin began to be overlaid upon them above. But as regards breath, there was none in them. (Ezekiel 37:8)

- And he went on saying to me; Prophesy to the wind. Prophesy, O son of man, and you must say to the wind; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; From the four winds come in, O wind, and blow upon these killed people, that they may come to life. (Ezekiel 37:9)
- And I prophesied just as he had commanded me, and the breath proceeded to come into them, and they began to live and stand upon their feet, a very, very great military force. (Ezekiel 37:10)
- The One making the word of his servant come true, and the One that carries out completely the counsel of his own messengers, the One saying of Jerusalem: She will be inhabited. And of the cities of Judah: They will be rebuilt, and her desolated places I shall raise up. (Isaiah 44:26)
- This is what Yehowah has said; In a time of goodwill I have answered you, and in a day of salvation I have helped you, and I kept safeguarding you that I might give you as a covenant for the people, to rehabilitate the land, to bring about the repossessing of the desolated hereditary possessions. (Isaiah 49:8)
- For Yehowah will certainly comfort Zion. He will for certain comfort all her devastated places, and he will make her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves will be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (Isaiah 51:3)
- And at your instance men will certainly build up the places devastated a long time, you will raise up even the foundations of continuous generations. And you will actually be called the repairer of the gap, the restorer of roadways by which to dwell. (Isaiah 58:12)
- But as for the courtyard that is outside the temple sanctuary, cast it clear out and do not measure it, because it has been given to the nations, and they will trample the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. (Revelation 11:2)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the day of my cleansing you from all your errors I will also cause the cities to be inhabited, and the devastated places must be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:33)
- Become cheerful, cry out joyfully in unison, you devastated places of Jerusalem, for Yehowah has comforted his people, he has repurchased Jerusalem. (Isaiah 52:9)

- Look! My servant will act with insight. He will be in high station and will certainly be elevated and exalted very much. (Isaiah 52:13)
- And it must occur that you will become many and certainly bear fruit in the land in those days, is the utterance of Yehowah. No more will they say, The ark of the covenant of Yehowah! nor will it come up into the heart, nor will they remember it or miss it, and no more will it be made. (Jeremiah 3:16)
- And I will multiply upon you humankind, the whole house of Israel, all of it, and the cities must become inhabited, and the devastated places themselves will be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:10)
