Isaiah 61:4· And they must rebuild the long-standing devastated places, they will raise up even the desolated places of former times, and they will certainly make anew the devastated cities, the places desolate for generation after generation.

[14] - References

- Immediately **after** the tribulation of those days the sun **will** be darkened, and the moon **will** not give its light, and the stars **will** fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens **will** be shaken. (**Matthew 24:29**)
- And then the sign of the Son of man **will** appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth **will** beat themselves in lamentation, and they **will** see the Son of man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (**Matthew 24:30**)
- But now do not feel hurt and do not be angry with yourselves because **you** sold me here, because for the preservation of life God has sent me ahead of **you**. (**Genesis 45:5**)
- For this is the second year of the famine in the midst of the earth, and there are yet five years in which there **will** be no plowing time or harvest. (**Genesis 45:6**)
- Consequently God sent me ahead of **you** in order to place a remnant for **you** men in the earth and to keep **you** alive by a great escape. (**Genesis 45:7**)
- And I prophesied just as I had been commanded. And a sound began to occur as soon as I prophesied, and here there was a rattling, and bones began to approach, bone to its bone. (**Ezekiel 37:7**)
- And I saw, and, look! Upon them sinews themselves and flesh itself came up and skin began to be overlaid upon them above. But as regards breath, there was none in them. (**Ezekiel 37:8**)

- And he went on saying to me; Prophecy to the wind. Prophecy, O son of man, and you must say to the wind; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; From the four winds come in, O wind, and blow upon these killed people, that they may come to life. (Ezekiel 37:9)
- And I prophesied just as he had commanded me, and the breath proceeded to come into them, and they began to live and stand upon their feet, a very, very great military force. (Ezekiel 37:10)
- The One making the word of his servant come true, and the One that carries out completely the counsel of his own messengers, the One saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be inhabited. And of the **cities** of Judah: They **will** be rebuilt, and her **desolated places** I shall **raise** up. (Isaiah 44:26)
- This is what Yehowah has said; In a time of goodwill I have answered you, and in a day of salvation I have helped you, and I kept safeguarding you that I might give you as a covenant for the people, to rehabilitate the land, to bring about the repossessing of the **desolated** hereditary possessions. (Isaiah 49:8)
- For Yehowah **will certainly** comfort Zion. He **will** for certain comfort all her **devastated places**, and he **will make** her wilderness like Eden and her desert plain like the garden of Yehowah. Exultation and rejoicing themselves **will** be found in her, thanksgiving and the voice of melody. (Isaiah 51:3)
- And at your instance men **will certainly** build up the **places devastated** a long time, you **will raise** up **even** the foundations of continuous **generations**. And you **will** actually be called the repairer of the gap, the restorer of roadways by which to dwell. (Isaiah 58:12)
- But as for the courtyard that is outside the temple sanctuary, cast it clear out and do not measure it, because it has been given to the nations, and they **will** trample the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. (Revelation 11:2)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the day of my cleansing **YOU** from all **YOUR** errors I **will** also cause the **cities** to be inhabited, and the **devastated places** must be rebuilt. (Ezekiel 36:33)
- Become cheerful, cry out joyfully in unison, **you devastated places** of Jerusalem, for Yehowah has comforted his people, he has repurchased Jerusalem. (Isaiah 52:9)

- Look! My servant **will** act with insight. He **will** be in high station and **will certainly** be elevated and exalted very much. (**Isaiah 52:13**)
- And it must occur that **you will** become many and **certainly** bear fruit in the land in those days, is the utterance of Yehowah. No more **will** they say, The ark of the covenant of Yehowah! nor **will** it come up into the heart, nor **will** they remember it or miss it, and no more **will** it be made. (**Jeremiah 3:16**)
- And I **will** multiply upon **you** humankind, the whole house of Israel, all of it, and the **cities** must become inhabited, and the **devastated places** themselves **will** be rebuilt. (**Ezekiel 36:10**)
- And I **will** gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they **will** actually build the **desolated cities** and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and **make** gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
