Zechariah 2:8" For this is what Yehowah of armies has said; Following after the glory he has sent me to the nations that were despoiling you people, for he that is touching you is touching my eyeball.

- To you the very glory of Lebanon will come, the juniper tree, the ash tree and the cypress at the same time, in order to beautify the place of my sanctuary, and I shall glorify the very place of my feet. (Isaiah 60:13)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am extending to her peace just like a river and the glory of nations just like a flooding torrent, and you will certainly suck. Upon the flank you will be carried, and upon the knees you will be fondled. (Isaiah 66:12)
- And I myself shall become to her, is the utterance of Yehowah, a wall of fire all around, and a glory is what I shall become in the midst of her. (Zechariah 2:5)
