~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Zion** - For any nation or Kingdom that will not serve you will perish and the former nations will without fail come to devastation· (Isaiah 60:12) ^[16] - References

Isaiah 60:12· For any nation and any kingdom that will not serve you will perish, and the nations themselves will without fail come to devastation.

^[16] - References

- And the heaven departed as a scroll that is being rolled up, and every mountain and every island were removed from their places. (Revelation 6:14)
- And the seventh angel blew his trumpet. And loud voices occurred in heaven, saying; The **kingdom** of the world did become the **kingdom** of our Lord and of his Christ, and he **will** rule as king forever and ever. (Revelation 11:15)
- And the twenty-four elders who were seated before God upon their thrones fell upon their faces and worshiped God. (Revelation 11:16)
- But the **nations** became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to give their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth. (Revelation 11:18)
- And still another angel emerged from the altar and he had authority over the fire. And he called out with a loud voice to the one that had the sharp sickle, saying; Put your sharp sickle in and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, because its grapes have become ripe. (Revelation 14:18)
- And the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and he hurled it into the great winepress of the anger of God. (Revelation 14:19)

- And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress as high up as the bridles of the horses, for a distance of a thousand six hundred furlongs. ([Revelation 14:20](#))
- Also, every island fled, and mountains were not found. ([Revelation 16:20](#))
- And I saw the wild beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage the war with the one seated on the horse and with his army. ([Revelation 19:19](#))
- And the wild beast was caught, and along with it the false prophet that performed in front of it the signs with which he misled those who received the mark of the wild beast and those who render worship to its image. While still alive, they both were hurled into the fiery lake that burns with sulphur. ([Revelation 19:20](#))
- But the rest were killed off with the long sword of the one seated on the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth. And all the birds were filled from the fleshy parts of them. ([Revelation 19:21](#))
- Look! All those getting heated up against you **will** become ashamed and be humiliated. The men in a quarrel with you **will** become as nothing and **will perish**. ([Isaiah 41:11](#))
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and **you** may not **perish** from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. ([Psalms 2:12](#))
- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven **will** set up a **kingdom** that **will** never be brought to ruin. And the **kingdom** itself **will** not be passed on to any other people. It **will** crush and put an end to all these **kingdoms**, and it itself **will** stand to times indefinite. ([Daniel 2:44](#))
- Moreover, these enemies of mine that did not want me to become king over them **BRING** here and slaughter them before me. ([Luke 19:27](#))
- And he shall shepherd the people with an iron rod so that they **will** be broken to pieces like clay vessels, the same as I have received from my Father. ([Revelation 2:27](#))
- Let all that is by the order of the God of the heavens be done with zeal for the house of the God of the heavens, that there may occur no wrath against the king's realm and his sons. ([Ezra 7:23](#))

- But if they **will** not obey, I **will** also uproot that nation, uprooting and destroying it, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 12:17**)
- And the **kingdom** and the rulership and the grandeur of the **kingdoms** under all the heavens were given to the people who are the holy ones of the Supreme One. Their **kingdom** is an indefinitely lasting **kingdom**, and all the rulerships **will serve** and obey even them. (**Daniel 7:27**)
- And he **will** certainly render judgment among many peoples, and set matters straight respecting mighty **nations** far away. And they **will** have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. They **will** not lift up sword, nation against nation, neither **will** they learn war anymore. (**Micah 4:3**)
- And I shall certainly overthrow the throne of **kingdoms** and annihilate the strength of the **kingdoms** of the **nations**, and I **will** overthrow the chariot and its riders, and the horses and their riders **will** certainly **come** down, each one by the sword of his brother. (**Haggai 2:22**)
- And it must occur that, as regards anyone that does not **come** up out of the families of the earth to Jerusalem to bow down to the King, Yehowah of armies, even upon them no pouring rain **will** occur. (**Zechariah 14:17**)
