For in me the islands themselves will keep hoping, the ships of Tarshish also as at the first, in order to bring your sons from far away, their silver and their gold being with them, to the name of Yehowah your God and to the Holy One of Israel, for he will have beautified you.

- This is what Yehowah has said, your Repurchaser, the Holy One of Israel; I, Yehowah, am your God, the One teaching you to benefit yourself, the One causing you to tread in the way in which you should walk. (Isaiah 48:17)
- My righteousness is near. My salvation will certainly go forth, and my own arms will judge even the peoples. In me the islands themselves will hope, and for my arm they will wait. (Isaiah 51:5)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more will there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (Isaiah 52:1)
- Look! A nation that you do not know you will call, and those of a nation who have not known you will run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your God, and for the Holy One of Israel, because he will have beautified you. (Isaiah 55:5)
- Raise your eyes all around and see! They have all of them been collected together, they have come to you. From far away your own sons keep coming, and your daughters who will be taken care of on the flank. (Isaiah 60:4)
- And they will actually bring all YOUR brothers out of all the nations as a gift to Yehowah, on horses and in chariots and in covered wagons and on mules and on swift she-camels, up to my holy mountain,

Jerusalem, Yehowah has said, just as when the sons of Israel bring the gift in a clean vessel into the house of Yehowah. (Isaiah 66:20)

- And blessed be his glorious name to time indefinite, and let his glory fill the whole earth. Amen and Amen. (Psalms 72:19)
- For Yehowah is taking pleasure in his people. He beautifies the meek ones with salvation. (Psalms 149:4)
