~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Zion** - For in me islands themselves will keep hoping in order to bring your sons from far away along with gifts of silver and gold to the name of Yehowah your God for he will have beautified you' (**Isaiah 60:9**) ^[19] - References

Isaiah 60:9· For in me the islands themselves will keep hoping, the ships of Tarshish also as at the first, in order to bring your sons from far away, their silver and their gold being with them, to the name of Yehowah your God and to the Holy One of Israel, for he will have beautified you.

- This is what **Yehowah** has said, your Repurchaser, the **Holy One** of **Israel**; I, **Yehowah**, am your **God**, the **One** teaching you to benefit yourself, the **One** causing you to tread in the way in which you should walk. (**Isaiah 48:17**)
- My righteousness is near. My salvation **will** certainly go forth, and my own arms **will** judge even the peoples. In me the islands themselves **will** hope, and for my arm they **will** wait. (**Isaiah 51:5**)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more **will** there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (**Isaiah 52:1**)
- Look! A nation that you do not know you **will** call, and those of a nation who **have** not known you **will** run even to you, for the sake of **Yehowah** your **God**, and for the **Holy One** of **Israel**, because he **will** **have beautified** you. (**Isaiah 55:5**)
- Raise your eyes all around and see! They **have** all of them been collected together, they **have** come to you. From **far away** your own **sons keep** coming, and your daughters who **will** be taken care of on the flank. (**Isaiah 60:4**)
- And they **will** actually **bring** all **YOUR** brothers out of all the nations as a gift to **Yehowah**, on horses and in chariots and in covered wagons and on mules and on swift she-camels, up to my holy mountain,

Jerusalem, **Yehowah** has said, just as when the **sons** of **Israel** bring the gift in a clean vessel into the house of **Yehowah**. (**Isaiah 66:20**)

- And blessed be his glorious **name** to time indefinite, and let his glory fill the whole earth. Amen and Amen. (**Psalms 72:19**)
- For **Yehowah** is taking pleasure in his people. He beautifies the meek ones with salvation. (**Psalms 149:4**)
- And again Isaiah says: There **will** be the root of Jesse, and there **will** be one arising to rule nations, on him nations **will** rest their hope. (**Romans 15:12**)
- For the king had a fleet of **ships** of **Tarshish** on the sea along with Hiram's fleet of **ships**. Once every three years the fleet of **ships** of **Tarshish** would come carrying **gold** and **silver**, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (**1 Kings 10:22**)
- And also to the foreigner, who is no part of your people **Israel** and who actually comes from a distant land by reason of your **name** (**1 Kings 8:41**)
- And Judah itself also **will** be warring at Jerusalem, and the wealth of all the nations round about **will** certainly be gathered, **gold** and **silver** and garments in excessive abundance. (**Zechariah 14:14**)
- A light for removing the veil from the nations and a glory of your people Israel. (**Luke 2:32**)
- I too, I shall laud you on an instrument of a stringed sort, as regards your trueness, O my **God**. I **will** make melody to you on the harp, O **Holy One** of **Israel**. (**Psalms 71:22**)
- The kings of **Tarshish** and of the islands, Tribute they **will** pay. The kings of Sheba and of Seba, a gift they **will** present. (**Psalms 72:10**)
- **Yehowah** himself has become king! Let the earth be joyful. Let the many islands rejoice. (**Psalms 97:1**)
- That is why in the region of light they must glorify **Yehowah**, in the islands of the sea the **name** of **Yehowah**, the **God** of **Israel**. (**Isaiah 24:15**)
- Listen to me, O **you** islands, and pay attention, **you** national groups **far away**. **Yehowah** himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my **name**. (**Isaiah 49:1**)

- The **ships** of **Tarshish** were your caravans for your articles of exchange, so that you get filled and become very glorious in the heart of the open sea. (**Ezekiel 27:25**)
