Isaiah 60:10... And foreigners will actually build your walls, and their own kings will minister to you, for in my indignation I shall have struck you, but in my goodwill I shall certainly have mercy upon you.

- And in that day you **will** be sure to say; I shall thank you, O Yehowah, for although you got incensed at me, your anger gradually turned back, and you proceeded to comfort me. (**Isaiah 12:1**)
- And **kings** must become caretakers for you, and their princesses nursing women for you. With faces to the earth they **will** bow down to you, and the dust of your feet they **will** lick up, and you **will have** to know that I am Yehowah, of whom those hoping in me **will** not be ashamed. (**Isaiah 49:23**)
- For a little moment I left you entirely, but with great mercies I shall collect you together. (**Isaiah 54:7**)
- At the erroneousness of his unjust gain I grew indignant, and I proceeded to strike him, concealing my face, while I was indignant. But he kept walking as a renegade in the way of his heart. (**Isaiah 57:17**)
- Because being under his anger is for a moment, being under his **goodwill** is for a lifetime. In the evening weeping may take up lodging, but in the morning there is a joyful cry. (**Psalms 30:5**)
- And I went on to say to the king; If to the king it does seem good, let letters be given me to the governors beyond the River, that they may let me pass until I come to Judah. (**Nehemiah 2:7**)
- And the Nethinim themselves happened to be dwellers in Ophel, they did repair work as far as in front of the Water Gate on the east and the protruding tower. (**Nehemiah 3:26**)

- Blessed be Yehowah the God of our forefathers, who has put such a thing into the heart of the king, to beautify the house of Yehowah, which is in Jerusalem! (**Ezra 7:27**)
- And the nations **will** walk by means of its light, and the **kings** of the earth **will** bring their glory into it. (**Revelation 21:24**)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you **mercy** and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)
- If your dispersed people should be at the end of the heavens, from there Yehowah your God **will** collect you and from there he **will** take you. (**Deuteronomy 30:4**)
- Yehowah your God **will** indeed bring you into the land of which your fathers took possession, and you **will certainly** take possession of it, and he **will** indeed do you good and multiply you more than your fathers. (**Deuteronomy 30:5**)
- And Yehowah your God **will have** to circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, that you may love Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul for the sake of your life. (**Deuteronomy 30:6**)
- And Yehowah your God **will certainly** put all these oaths upon your enemies and those who hate you, who **have** persecuted you. (**Deuteronomy 30:7**)
- And I shall humiliate the offspring of David on account of this, only not always. (**1 Kings 11:39**)
- You yourself **will** arise, you **will have mercy** on Zion, for it is the season to be favorable to her, for the appointed time has come. (**Psalms 102:13**)
- The One making the word of his servant come true, and the One that carries out completely the counsel of his **own** messengers, the One saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be inhabited. And of the cities of Judah: They **will** be rebuilt, and her desolated places I shall raise up. (**Isaiah 44:26**)
- And let not the foreigner that has joined himself to Yehowah say, Without doubt Yehowah **will** divide me off from his people. Neither let the eunuch say, Look! I am a dry tree. (**Isaiah 56:3**)

- And strangers **will actually** stand and shepherd the flocks of **YOU** people, and the foreigners **will** be **YOUR** farmers and **YOUR** vinedressers. (**Isaiah 61:5**)
- And Yehowah **will** be zealous for his land and **will** show compassion upon his people. (**Joel 2:18**)
- And those who are far away **will** come and **actually build** in the temple of Yehowah. And **you** people **will have** to know that Yehowah of armies himself has sent me to **YOU**. And it must occur, if **YOU will** without fail listen to the voice of Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Zechariah 6:15**)
