• And in that day you will be sure to say; I shall thank you, O Yehowah, for although you got incensed at me, your anger gradually turned back, and you proceeded to comfort me. (Isaiah 12:1)

And kings must become caretakers for you, and their princesses nursing women for you. With faces to the earth they will bow down to you, and the dust of your feet they will lick up, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah, of whom those hoping in me will not be ashamed. (Isaiah 49:23)

• For a little moment I left you entirely, but with great mercies I shall collect you together. (Isaiah 54:7)

• At the erroneousness of his unjust gain I grew indignant, and I proceeded to strike him, concealing my face, while I was indignant. But he kept walking as a renegade in the way of his heart. (Isaiah 57:17)
