

**ZION - THOSE WHO ONCE AFFLICTED YOU WILL NOW BOW**

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Zion** - Those who once afflicted you will now bow before you and all those who treated you disrespectfully must touch their faces to the ground, they will call you the city of Yehowah, Zion (Isaiah 60:14) [20] - References

**Isaiah 60:14** And to you the sons of those afflicting you must go, bowing down, and all those treating you disrespectfully must bend down at the very soles of your feet, and they will have to call you the city of Yehowah, Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

- And peoples **will** actually take them and bring them to their own place, and the house of **Israel** **must** take them to themselves as a possession upon the soil of **Yehowah** as menservants and as maidservants, and they **must** become the captors of those holding them captive, and they **must have** in subjection those who were driving them to work. (Isaiah 14:2)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; The unpaid laborers of Egypt and the merchants of Ethiopia and the Sabeans, tall men, **will** themselves come over even to you, and yours they **will** become. Behind you they **will** walk, in fetters they **will** come over, and to you they **will** bow down. To you they **will** pray, saying; Indeed God is in union with you, and there is no one else, there is no other God. (Isaiah 45:14)
- And men **will** certainly **call** them the holy people, those repurchased by **Yehowah**, and you yourself **will** be called, **Searched For, a City Not Left Entirely**. (Isaiah 62:12)
- Pretty for loftiness, the exultation of the whole earth, is Mount **Zion** on the remote sides of the north, the town of the grand King. (Psalms 48:2)
- Glorious things are being spoken about you, O **city** of the true God. (Psalms 87:3)
- O **Yehowah** my strength and my stronghold, and my place for flight in the day of distress, to you the nations themselves **will** come from the ends of the earth, and they **will** say; Indeed our forefathers

came to possess sheer falsehood, vanity and things in which there was nothing beneficial. (Jeremiah 16:19)

- Look! I **will** give those from the synagogue of Satan who say they are Jews, and yet they are not but are lying, look! I **will** make them come and do obeisance before your **feet** and make them know I **have** loved you. (Revelation 3:9)

- But **you have** approached a Mount **Zion** and a **city** of the living God, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (Hebrews 12:22)

- Your **sons have** hurried up. The very ones tearing you **down** and devastating you **will go** forth even from you. (Isaiah 49:17)

- Only it **will** not be all the kingdom that I shall rip away. **One** tribe I shall give to your son, for the sake of David my servant and for the sake of Jerusalem which I **have** chosen. (1 Kings 11:13)

- And he went sending again a third chief of fifty and his fifty. But the third chief of fifty went up and came and bent **down** upon his knees in front of Elijah and began to implore favor of him and speak to him; Man of the true God, please let my soul and the soul of these fifty servants of yours be precious in your eyes. (2 Kings 1:13)

- There is a river the streams of which make the **city** of God rejoice, the holiest grand tabernacle of the Most High. (Psalms 46:4)

- Bad people **will have** to bow **down** before the good ones, and the wicked people at the gates of the righteous one. (Proverbs 14:19)

- And they **must** fly at the shoulder of the Philistines to the west, together they **will** plunder the **sons** of the East. Edom and Moab **will** be those upon whom they **will** thrust out their hand, and the **sons** of Ammon **will** be their subjects. (Isaiah 11:14)

- And I shall put my words in your mouth, and with the shadow of my hand I shall certainly cover you, in order to plant the heavens and lay the foundation of the earth and say to **Zion**, You are my people. (Isaiah 51:16)

- Hear the word of **Yehowah**, **you** men who are trembling at his word; **YOUR** brothers that are hating **you**, that are excluding **you** by reason of my name, said; May **Yehowah** be glorified! He **must** also appear with rejoicing on **YOUR** part, and they are the ones that **will** be put to shame. (Isaiah 66:5)

- And I shall cause no further humiliating talk by the nations to be heard concerning you, and reproach by peoples you **will** bear no more,

and your nations you **will** no more cause to stumble, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 36:15**)

- Here I am acting against all those **afflicting** you, at that time, and I **will** save her that is limping, and her that is dispersed I shall collect together. And I **will** set them as a praise and as a name in all the land of their shame. (**Zephaniah 3:19**)

- This is what **Yehowah** has said; I **will** return to **Zion** and reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and Jerusalem **will** certainly be called the **city** of trueness, and the mountain of **Yehowah** of armies, the holy mountain. (**Zechariah 8:3**)

- And I **will** remove his bloodstained things from his mouth and his disgusting things from between his teeth, and he himself also **will** certainly be left remaining for our God, and he **must** become like a sheik in Judah, and Ekron like the Jebusite. (**Zechariah 9:7**)
