Isaiah 30:19 When the very people in Zion will dwell in Jerusalem, you will by no means weep. He will without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he will actually answer you.

- In distress you called, and I proceeded to rescue you, I began to **answer** you in the concealed place of thunder. I went examining you at the waters of Meribah. (**Psalms 81:7**)
- And respecting **Zion** it **will** be said; Each and every one was born in her. And the Most High himself **will** firmly establish her. (**Psalms 87:5**)
- For the sake of **Zion** I shall not keep still, and for the sake of **Jerusalem** I shall not stay quiet until her righteousness goes forth just like the brightness, and her salvation like a torch that burns. (**Isaiah 62:1**)
- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. Even in my saying of **Jerusalem**: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will** have your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- To assign to those mourning over **Zion**, to give them a headdress instead of ashes, the oil of exultation instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of the downhearted spirit, and they must be called big trees of righteousness, the planting of Yehowah, for him to be beautified. (**Isaiah 61:3**)
- For there exists a day when the lookouts in the mountainous region of Ephraim **will actually** call out; Rise up, O men, and let us go up to **Zion**, to Yehowah our God. (**Jeremiah 31:6**)

- Call out further, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; My cities **will** yet overflow with goodness, and Yehowah **will** yet certainly feel regrets over **Zion** and yet **actually** choose Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 1:17**)
- Now the princes of the people had their dwelling in **Jerusalem**, but as for the rest of the people, they cast lots to bring in one out of every ten to **dwell** in **Jerusalem** the holy city, and the nine other parts in the other cities. (**Nehemiah 11:1**)
- And at the inauguration of the wall of **Jerusalem** they looked for the Levites, to bring them out of all their places to **Jerusalem** to carry on an inauguration and a rejoicing even with thanksgivings and with song, cymbals and stringed instruments and with harps. (**Nehemiah 12:27**)
- And call me in the day of distress. I shall rescue you, and you **will** glorify me. (**Psalms 50:15**)
- And **you will** certainly call me and come and pray to me, and I **will** listen to **you**. (**Jeremiah 29:12**)
- Get away from me, all **you** practicers of what is hurtful, for Yehowah **will** certainly hear the **sound** of my weeping. (**Psalms 6:8**)
- And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah **will** return and certainly come to **Zion** with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite **will** be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they **will** attain, and grief and sighing must flee away. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- No more **will** your sun set, nor **will** your moon go on the wane, for Yehowah himself **will** become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your mourning **will** have come to completion. (**Isaiah 60:20**)
- Yehowah is not slow respecting his promise, as some people consider slowness, but he is patient with **you** because he does not desire any to be destroyed but desires all to attain to repentance. (**2 Peter 3:9**)
