

John 10:1~ Most truly I say to you, he that does not enter into the sheepfold through the door, but climbs up some other place, that one is a thief and a plunderer.

1· Next Jesus gives an illustration of a sheepfold, showing that the one that does not enter into the sheepfold by means of the door, is either a thief or a plunderer. This referred to the Jewish religious leaders, who had entered God's sheepfold by devious means, and not through the doing of his will.

[Question] What illustration did Jesus give next?

[Question] What is the one entering the sheepfold, not through the door?

[Question] Who did this refer to, for how must all enter into God's service?

2· Therefore Jesus said again; Most truly I say to you, I, am the door of the sheep. (John 10:7)

[Question] What did Jesus later state that he himself was, for whose example must men follow to serve Yehowah God faithfully henceforth?

3· Be on the watch for the false prophets that come to you in sheep's covering, but inside, they are ravenous wolves. (Matthew 7:15)

[Question] Who did Jesus tell his disciples to keep a watch out for?

4· And I have other sheep, which are not of this fold, those also I must bring, and they will listen to my voice, and they will become one flock, one shepherd. (John 10:16)

[Question] What sheep did Jesus tell his anointed Christian disciples that he would later gather, and what must the two flocks then become together?
