

John 10:14~ I am the fine¹ shepherd, and I know my sheep, and my sheep know me.

Footnote: Or, right

1· Contrasting this, Jesus showed, that he was a fine shepherd, who truly cared about the sheeplike ones under his care. He knew all of his sheep, and had come to love them, and they him.

[Question] How did Jesus contrast this, with what kind of a shepherd he was?

2· My sheep listen to my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. (John 10:27)

[Question] Whose voice do the fine sheep know well, and so what do they do, when this shepherd calls them out?

3· But we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity, that we may gain the knowledge of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and life everlasting. (1 John 5:20)

[Question] What had the Son of God given to anointed Christians, and to what end?

[Question] What does it mean, to be in union with Yehowah God and his Christ?

4· You are beautiful, O girl companion of mine, like Pleasant City, comely like Jerusalem, awesome as companies gathered around banners. (Song of Solomon 6:4)

[Question] How did the shepherd boy, view his girl companion?

5· Because the Lamb, who is in the midst of the throne, will shepherd them, and will guide them to fountains of waters of life. And God will wipe out every tear from their eyes. (Revelation 7:17)

[Question] What does the Revelation account show, that the Lamb will do for the sheep, and where will he lead them?
