John 10:17~ This is why the Father loves me, because I surrender my soul, in order, that I may receive it again.

1. So Jesus then told his disciples, that this was the very reason that Yehowah God loved him, because he was willing to surrender his very soul, in order, that he might receive it again.

[Question] What did Jesus reveal, was the reason why the Father loved him so much?

2. I in union with them, and you in union with me, in order, that they may be perfected into one, that the world may have the knowledge, that you sent me forth, and that you loved them, just as you loved me. (John 17:23)

[Question] What kind of unity did Jesus want his disciples to have, like he had, and what would this prove to others?

3. For that reason I shall deal him a portion among the many, and it will be with the mighty ones, that he will apportion the spoil, due to the fact, that he poured out his soul to the very death, and it was with the transgressors that he was counted in, and he himself carried the very sin of many people, and for the transgressors he proceeded to interpose. (Isaiah 53:12)

[Question] Why was Jesus given a portion among the mighty ones, for what did he willingly do in behalf of others?

4. More than that, when he found himself in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient as far as death, yes, death on a torture stake. (Philippians 2:8)

[Question] What did Jesus do to further humble himself, upon realizing that he was on earth as a man, and how far did he carry that obedience?

5. But we behold Jesus, who has been made a little lower than angels, crowned with glory and honor, for having suffered death, that he, by God's undeserved kindness, might taste death for every man. (Hebrews 2:9)

[Question] What has Jesus Christ been crowned with, and why?

[Question] How has he tasted death for every man?

6. As we look intently at the Chief Agent and Perfecter of our faith, Jesus. For the joy that was set before him, he endured a torture stake, despising shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2)

[Question] Who is a fine example for Christians to follow closely?
[Question] What did Jesus willingly endure, and why, thus where does he now sit in glory?

7. And he went on to say; Take, please, your son, your only son whom you so love, Isaac, and make a trip to the land of Moriah and there offer him up as a burnt offering, on one of the mountains that I shall designate to you. (Genesis 22:2)

[Question] How was this prophetic drama shown, in the Genesis account of Abraham and Isaac?

8. For the Father has affection for the Son, and shows him all the things he himself does, and he will show him works greater than these, in order, that you may marvel. (John 5:20)

[Question] How does the Father feel about the Son, and so what does he show the Son, and what will he yet show the Son?

9. Although he was a Son, he learned obedience from the things he suffered. (Hebrews 5:8)

[Question] What did Jesus have to learn from things he suffered?
