

John 10:20~ Many of them were saying; He has a demon and is mad. Why do you listen to him?

- 1· Some within the crowd were saying, that Jesus had a demon, or that he had gone crazy, and they were questioning others; Why do you listen to him?

[Question] What did some within the crowds say about Jesus?

- 2· Correspondingly, John came neither eating nor drinking, yet people say, He **has** a demon. (**Matthew 11:18**)

[Question] What did they also say about John the Baptist, who lived a very different life from Jesus?

- 3· This, because they were **saying**; He **has** an unclean spirit. (**Mark 3:30**)

[Question] What did some think that Jesus had, within him, after hearing his words?

- 4· Correspondingly, John the Baptist **has** come neither eating bread nor drinking wine, but you say; He **has** a demon. (**Luke 7:33**)

[Question] What did men say about John the Baptist, though he was very conservative in his ways, like prophets of old were?

- 5· But when his relatives heard about it, they went out to lay hold of him, for they were **saying**; He **has** gone out of his mind. (**Mark 3:21**)

[Question] What did Jesus own relatives think about his preaching works at first?

- 6· The crowd answered; You have a **demon**. Who is seeking to kill you? (**John 7:20**)

[Question] How did many in the crowds react, when he said they were trying to kill him?

- 7· In answer the Jews said to him; Do we not rightly say, you are a Samaritan, and have a demon? (**John 8:48**)

[Question] What did the Pharisees say to denounce him before the people, though neither statement was true?

- 8· The Jews said to him; Now we do know you have a demon. Abraham died, also the prophets. But you say; If anyone observes my word, he will never taste death at all. (John 8:52)**

[Question] How did Jesus words, about men never dying who observed his words, have upon the crowds listening to it?
