- 1· Jesus himself was then walking about in the temple in the colonnade of Solomon.**

[Question] Where then, was Jesus walking about?

- 2· Well, as the man was holding onto Peter and John, all the people ran together to them at what was called Solomon's colonnade, surprised out of their wits. (Acts of Apostles 3:11)**

[Question] Where were Peter and John later, when a crowd ran together to them, over a healing they performed?

- 3· Moreover, through the hands of the apostles many signs and portents continued to occur among the people, and they were all with one accord in Solomon's colonnade. (Acts of Apostles 5:12)**

[Question] Where did the apostles gather together often, to perform powerful works among the people of Israel?

- 4· As for the great courtyard, roundabout were three rows of hewn stone and a row of beams of cedarwood, and this also for the inner courtyard of the house of Yehowah, and for the porch of the house. (1 Kings 7:12)**

[Question] What was the construction of this area like?
