1· Then he told them, that they failed to put faith in him, because they simply were not his sheep.

[Question] Why then, did Jesus tell the crowds, that they failed to put faith in him?

2· But there are some of you that do not believe. For from the beginning, Jesus knew who were the ones not believing, and who was the one that would betray him. (John 6:64)

[Question] Did Jesus ever expect, that all people would believe and accept his message of salvation?

3· He that is from God, listens to the sayings of God. This is why you do not listen, because you are not from God. (John 8:47)

[Question] What does the one from God listen to, and so why did some men refuse to listen to Jesus' teachings?

4· We originate with God. He that gains the knowledge of God listens to us. He that does not originate with God does not listen to us. This is how we take note of the inspired expression of truth, and the inspired expression of error. (1 John 4:6)
