John 10:27~ My sheep listen to my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.

1. Jesus then told them, that those who are his sheep, listen to his voice. Thereafter, he gets to know them, and they him, and so they follow him.

[Question] What do those who are Jesus' sheep listen to, and so who do they follow?

2. And when he gets home he calls his friends and his neighbors together, saying to them; Rejoice with me, because I have found my sheep that was lost. (Luke 15:6)

[Question] How does the fine shepherd feel about lost sheep?

3. The doorkeeper opens to this one, and the sheep listen to his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. (John 10:3)

[Question] Whose voice does the doorkeeper open to at hearing it, and who also listens?

[Question] How does the fine shepherd get his sheep to follow him?

4. At once abandoning the nets, they followed him. (Matthew 4:20)

[Question] How did Jesus' early disciples view the privilege of becoming his disciples?

5. Next, while passing along from there, Jesus caught sight of a man named Matthew, seated at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. Thereupon he did rise up and follow him. (Matthew 9:9)

[Question] How did Matthew respond to Jesus' call; Come be my follower?

6. These are the ones, that did not defile themselves with women, in fact, they are virgins. These are the ones, that keep following the Lamb no matter where he goes. These were bought from among mankind, as firstfruits to God and to the Lamb. (Revelation 14:4)

[Question] What man alone do anointed Christians follow faithfully?

7. The sound of my dear one! Look! This one is coming, climbing upon the mountains, leaping upon the hills. (Song of Solomon 2:8)

[Question] How does the Song of Solomon show how the virgin girl feels at the voice of her beloved one?

8. Look! Yehowah himself has caused it to be heard to the farthest part of the earth; Say, you people, to the daughter of Zion; Look! Your salvation is coming. Look! The reward he gives is with him, and the wages he pays are before him. (Isaiah 62:11)

[Question] What call is made to the daughter of Zion, for what does he, the Messiah, bring to her?

9. And they will have to know, that I am Yehowah, when I make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, on account of all their detestable things that they have done. (Ezekiel 33:29)

[Question] What would Yehowah God do to his land, and over what bad dealings of his covenant people?

10. Shepherd your people with your staff, the flock of your inheritance, the one who was residing alone in a forest, in the midst of an orchard. Let them feed on Bashan and Gilead, as in the days of a long time ago. (Micah 7:14)

[Question] What did Micah call upon the great shepherd, Yehowah God to do for his people, and what fine pasturage would he lead them to?

11. Consequently many more believed on account of what he said. (John 4:41)

[Question] How did many people put faith in Jesus, and why?

12. I am the fine shepherd, and I know my sheep and my sheep know me. (John 10:14)

[Question] What did Jesus say of himself, and is he intimately acquainted with?

13. We originate with God. He that gains the knowledge of God listens to us. He that does not originate with God does not listen to us. This is how we take note of the inspired

expression of truth, and the inspired expression of error. (1 John 4:6)

[Question] Who listens to the preaching efforts of anointed Christians, and who does not listen to this?

[Question] What does this help anointed Christians to take note of?
