John 10:28~ And I give them everlasting life, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.

1• Jesus then showed, that he gave to his true followers everlasting life, and not one of them would by any means ever by destroyed. Also he showed, that no one would be able to snatch even one of them, out of his protective and loving care.

[Question] What then, did Jesus show, that he as the fine shepherd gives to his sheep?

[Question] Would anyone else ever be able to snatch them out of his loving and protective care?

2. Most truly I say to you, he that hears my word and believes him that sent me has everlasting life, and he does not come into judgment, but has passed over, from death to life. (John 5:24)

[Question] What does the one hearing Jesus' word, and believing it, have?

[Question] What had such a one passed over from, and to?

3. According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (John 17:2)

[Question] What authority does Jesus Christ have over all flesh, and what does he give to those who have been given to him by Yehowah God?

Everything the Father gives me, will come to me, and the one that comes to me, I will by no means drive away. (John 6:37)

[Question] Who would be drawn to Jesus' message, and would Jesus ever drive away such ones who put faith in him?

5. In order, that the word might be fulfilled which he said; Of those whom you have given me, I have not lost a single one. (John 18:9)

[Question] Who did Jesus lovingly protect and shepherd under his care?

6 For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds

the Son and exercises faith in him, should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

[Question] What is the will of Yehowah God for his sons, and when will this life start?

7' When I was with them, I used to watch over them, on account of your own name, which you have given me. I have kept them, and not one of them is destroyed, except the son of destruction, in order, that the scripture might be fulfilled. (John 17:12)

[Question] What did Jesus state to his disciples, before Yehowah God, on the night of his death as a man?

[Question] Who alone of all his disciples, would be lost to the sheepfold, and why?
