^{John 10:29~} What my Father has given me, is something greater than all other things,¹ and no one can snatch them out of the hand of the Father.

1[•] Then Jesus told his disciples, that what the Father had given him was greater than all other things. Christ is the heir of Yehowah God, and therefore the heir of all creation. Because of this, no one would be able to snatch them out of God's hand.

[Question] What does Jesus Christ inherit, and how great is this in respect to all others?

[Question] As such, what cannot be taken from him by anyone?

2. You heard that I said to you; I am going away and I am coming back to you. If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going my way to the Father, because the Father, is greater than I am. (John 14:28)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples on the night of his death, that he was going away to, and why should this have made them rejoice?

3. According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (John 17:2)

[Question] What authority does Jesus have over all flesh, and what will he give to faithful and obedient ones?

4. Father, as to what you have given me, I wish, that where I am, they also may be with me, in order to behold my glory that you have given me, because you loved me before the founding of the world. (John 17:24)

[Question] What glory did Jesus want his disciples to see for themselves, that Jesus possessed, before coming to the earth?

5. Who are being safeguarded by God's power through faith, for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last period of time. (1 Peter 1:5)

[Question] What are anointed Christians being safeguarded for, and through what, and when will this come?

6. I have made your name manifest, to the men you gave me out of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word. (John 17:6)

[Question] Whose name did Jesus make manifest to his disciples, and what had these disciples done respecting God's word?
