The doorkeeper opens to this one, and the sheep listen to his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name, and leads them out.

1. So Jesus showed, that the doorkeeper opens to the true shepherd, and also the sheep listen to his voice, and he calls his own sheep out by name, and leads them out.

[Question] Who did Jesus show, that the doorkeeper would open to, and why?

[Question] Whose voice do the sheep listen to, and how does the fine shepherd lead his sheep out?

2. Look! I am sending my messenger, and he must clear up a way before me. And suddenly, there will come to His temple, the true Lord, whom you people are seeking, and the messenger of the covenant, in whom you are delighting. Look! He will certainly come, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 3:1)

[Question] Who did Malachi state was coming to his temple, and what did he bring with him?

3. Also, he will go before him with Elijah's spirit and power, to turn back the hearts of fathers to children, and the disobedient ones, to the practical wisdom of righteous ones, to get ready for Yehowah, a prepared people. (Luke 1:17)

[Question] What did the angel say to Zechariah that John the Baptist would perform in Yehowah God's behalf, and what would he get ready for Yehowah God?

4. You yourselves bear me witness that I said; I am not the Christ. But, I have been sent forth in advance of that one. (John 3:28)

[Question] What did John the Baptist bear witness to others, about himself?

5. My sheep listen to my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. (John 10:27)

[Question] Whose voice alone, do the sheep listen to, and follow after?

6. And speak to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord

Yehowah has said; Here I am taking the sons of Israel from among the nations to which they have gone, and I will collect them together from roundabout, and bring them onto their soil. (Ezekiel 37:21)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to do for the exiled people of Israel, through his prophet Ezekiel?

7: Jesus said to her; Mary! Upon turning around, she said to him, in Hebrew; *Rabboni!* Which means, Teacher! (John 20:16)

[Question] What did Mary address Jesus as, and what does this title of respect mean?

8. He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you know all things. You are aware that I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (John 21:17)

[Question] What did Jesus ask Peter three times, and what course did he tell Peter he should take, if he loved Jesus more than food?

[Question] What did this show, that Jesus viewed his disciples as before him?
