- 1· **So Jesus told them, that he had done many fine works before them, works that clearly came forth from the hand of God. So he asked them; For which one of these fine works are you stoning me?**

**[Question]** What then, did Jesus say in response to this, and what did he ask them?

- 2· **And he added; Why is this that my lord is chasing after his servant, for what have I done, and what badness is there in my hand? (1 Samuel 26:18)**

**[Question]** How was David treated similarly by Saul?

- 3· **They reward me with bad for good, bereavement to my soul. (Psalms 35:12)**

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist show, how the Messiah would be treated by his own people then?

- 4· **Likewise let your light shine before men, that they may see your fine works, and give glory to your Father, who is in the heavens. (Matthew 5:16)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples to let shine, for then what would men, even opposers have to admit?
