[Question] How was David treated similarly by Saul?

3. They reward me with bad for good, bereavement to my soul. (Psalms 35:12)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show, how the Messiah would be treated by his own people then?

4. Likewise let your light shine before men, that they may see your fine works, and give glory to your Father, who is in the heavens. (Matthew 5:16)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples to let shine, for then what would men, even opposers have to admit?
