

**John 10:34~ Jesus answered them; Is it not written in your Law: I said, you are gods?<sup>1</sup>**

**Footnote: You are gods** Greek, *the·oi' e·ste*; Latin, *di'i e'stis*; J17, 18, 22(Hebrew), *'elo·him' 'at·tem'*

**1· So Jesus quoted from the Psalms showing that even in their own Law is said when speaking about mere men; You are gods.**

**[Question]** What then, did Jesus quote from, and what did it show, that the scriptures say about mere men?

**2· But it is that the word written in their Law may be fulfilled: They hated me without cause. (John 15:25)**

**[Question]** What word was fulfilled in Jesus ministry, by his opposers, for did they have any valid reasons for hating Jesus?

**3· I myself have said, you are gods, and all of you are sons of the Most High. (Psalms 82:6)**

**[Question]** What does the Psalms state, regarding mere men?

**4· For even though there are those who are called gods, whether in heaven or on earth, just as there are many gods and many lords. (1 Corinthians 8:5)**

**[Question]** What are many called upon the earth, and what are there many of on earth?

**5· And he must speak for you to the people, and it must occur, that he will serve as a mouth to you, and you will serve as God to him. (Exodus 4:16)**

**[Question]** What was Moses told that he would serve as for Yehowah God?

**6· But the king said to her; Do not be afraid, but what did you see? And the woman went on to say to Saul; A god I saw coming up out of the earth. (1 Samuel 28:13)**

**[Question]** What did the widow of Endor tell Saul, that she saw coming up out of the earth?

**7· I shall laud you with all my heart. In front of other gods I shall make melody to you. (Psalms 138:1)**

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist express, before whom he would laud Yehowah God?
