

**John 10:36~** **Do you say to me<sup>1</sup> whom the Father sanctified and dispatched into the world, you blaspheme, because I said; I am God's Son?**

**Footnote: Or, of him**

**1· So in light of this scripture, he reasoned with them that they were unreasonable to say that he, whom God had dispatched and sanctified for this work, was blaspheming, merely because he said that he was God's Son.**

**[Question]** How did Jesus then reason with these men, showing them to be unreasonable?

**2· In answer the angel said to her; Holy Spirit will come upon you, and power of the Most High will overshadow you. For that reason also what is born, will be called holy, God's Son. (Luke 1:35)**

**[Question]** What was Mary told, that her son would come to be called, and why would he be holy?

**3· You must not call down evil upon God nor curse a chieftain among your people. (Exodus 22:28)**

**[Question]** What are men told not to show disrespect for, or call down evil upon, and why?

**4· And I will sanctify the tent of meeting and the altar, and I shall sanctify Aaron and his sons for them to act as priests to me. (Exodus 29:44)**

**[Question]** How did Yehowah God make holy, those who would minister to him in his presence?

**5· He has put his trust in God. Let Him now rescue him if He wants him, for he said; I am God's Son. (Matthew 27:43)**

**[Question]** What did some opposers of Jesus mockingly say against him, as he was being impaled?
