But if I am doing them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, in order, that you may come to know and may continue knowing, that the Father is in union with me and I am in union with the Father.

1' Yet if he was doing God's fine works, then they should believe in the works themselves. Through this they would come to know, that the Father was in union with him, and he in union with the Father. Thus they were united in the accomplishing of God's will for mankind, and the powerful works Jesus did, proved this beyond a shadow of a doubt, to any reasonable person.

[Question] What then, did Jesus tell them to put faith in, even if they did not accept him personally?

[Question] What would they come to know, through doing this?

[Question] What did Jesus' fine works, prove to any reasonable person?

2. Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father who remains in union with me is doing his works. (John 14:10)

**[Question]** Whose works and teachings were being exposed to mankind through Jesus Christ?

3. In order, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in union with me and I am in union with you, that they also may be in union with us, in order, that the world may believe, that you sent me forth. (John 17:21)

[Question] In what way did Jesus want his disciples to be one with him and Yehowah God, and what would this prove to others?

4. And it must occur that, to quote him, if they will not believe you, and will not listen to the voice of the first sign, then they will certainly believe the voice of the later sign.

(Exodus 4:8)

[Question] What was Moses given by Yehowah God, and what would this prove to others about Moses' commission?

5. In union with God, I shall praise his word, in union with Yehowah, I shall praise his word. (Psalms 56:10)

[Question] What did the Psalmist show, that one in union with Yehowah God would do?

6. All the same, wisdom is proved righteous by all its children. (Luke 7:35)

[Question] What proves whether a man speaks wisdom or foolishness?

7. On this account, indeed, the Jews began seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was also calling God his own Father, making himself equal to God. (John 5:18)

[Question] What were the primary reasons, why the Jews chose to hate Jesus?

8. Jesus answered them; I told you, and yet you do not believe. The works that I am doing in the name of my Father, these bear witness about me. (John 10:25)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his listeners, and what did the works he performed, that no other man have ever before done, prove about him?

9. I and the Father are one. (John 10:30)

[Question] What did Jesus mean, when he said, that he and the Father were one?

10" In that day you will know, that I am in union with my Father, and you are in union with me, and I am in union with you. (John 14:20)

[Question] What unity of thought and purpose, did Jesus show would come to his disciples through him toward God?

11. You yourselves are our letter, inscribed on our hearts and known and being read by all mankind. (2 Corinthians 3:2)

[Question] What were the anointed Christians in Corinth Greece like, regarding the ministry of the apostle Paul?
