John 10:40~ So he went off again across the Jordan, to the place where John was baptizing at first, and he stayed there.

1. So Jesus left Jerusalem and he went off across the Jordan River, to the same place, where John the Baptist had originally been baptizing people some time earlier.

[Question] Where then, did Jesus go to, upon leaving Jerusalem that winter, and who had earlier gone there?

2. These things took place in Bethany across the Jordan, where John was baptizing. (John 1:28)

[Question] Where then, did Jesus go to, to get away from these men and out of their reach?

3. Now when Jesus had finished these words, he departed from Galilee, and came to the frontiers of Judea across the Jordan. (Matthew 19:1)

[Question] Where did Jesus then go to, after finishing what he had to say to these men?

4. From there he rose and came to the frontiers of Judea and across the Jordan, and again crowds came together to him, and as he was accustomed to do, he again went teaching them. (Mark 10:1)

[Question] Where then, did Jesus go to preach and teach, and who followed after his to this place?
