

John 10:41~ And many people came to him, and they began saying; John, indeed, did not perform a single sign, but as many things as John said about this man, were all true.

1· There many people came out to him and they would testify, that John the Baptist did not perform a single sign. Yet all the things he had told the people about the one coming behind him, who would advance in front of him, these things had all come true, for Jesus performed many signs.

[Question] What then, did the people testify, about John the Baptist?

[Question] What witness of John the Baptist's though, about Jesus, had indeed come true?

2· The next day he beheld Jesus coming toward him, and he **said**; See, the Lamb of God, that takes away the sin of the world! (**John 1:29**)

[Question] What did John the Baptist say about Jesus, and his role before the world of mankind?

3· That one must go on increasing, but I must go on decreasing. (**John 3:30**)

[Question] What did John the Baptist say to his disciples, that his work would become, next to Jesus' work?

4· This is he, concerning whom it is written: Look! I myself, am sending forth my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way ahead of you! (**Matthew 11:10**)

[Question] How did John the Baptist fulfill the scripture in Malachi, for who would he prepare the way for?
