A stranger they will by no means follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers.

1. Then Jesus showed, that a stranger's voice they will by no means follow, for they know the voice of the shepherd, and they do not follow strangers.

[Question] Whose voice did Jesus show, that they would by no means follow, and why?

2. I know your deeds, and your labor and endurance, and that you cannot bear bad men, and that you put those to the test, who say they are apostles, but they are not, and you found them liars. (Revelation 2:2)

[Question] How did Jesus commend the congregations in Revelation, for who did they test out?

3. However, even if we or an angel out of heaven were to declare to you as Good News, something beyond what we declared to you as Good News, let him be accursed. (Galatians 1:8)

[Question] What did Paul say respecting anyone, who would try to change the Good News that he preached?

4. Look out! Perhaps there may be someone who will carry you off as his prey, through the philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary things of the world, and not according to Christ. (Colossians 2:8)

[Question] What did Paul tell anointed Christians to watch out for carefully?
