

John 10:7~ Therefore Jesus said again; **Most truly I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.**

- 1· So Jesus, sensing this, made it plain to them saying, that he was the door of the sheep.

[Question] How then did Jesus make this illustration plain to them, and what did he say that he was?

- 2· Jesus **said** to him; **I am** the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (**John 14:6**)

[Question] What did Jesus later say that he himself was, and how only could people come to the Father, Yehowah God?

- 3· Most **truly I say** to you, he that does not enter into the sheepfold through the **door**, but climbs up some other place, that one is a thief and a plunderer. (**John 10:1**)

[Question] What did Jesus state, that anyone entering the sheepfold not through the door, was, toward the sheep?

- 4· Now may the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great shepherd of the **sheep**, with the blood of an everlasting covenant, our Lord Jesus. (**Hebrews 13:20**)

[Question] How is Jesus Christ described by the apostle Paul in Hebrews?
