

John 10:9~ I am the door, whoever enters through me will be saved, and he will go in and out and find pasturage.

- 1· Jesus then reiterated again that he was the door of the sheepfold. All those entering through him would be saved, and they would become part of the flock that God himself would shepherd and give fine pasturage to.

[Question] What did Jesus again say, that he was toward the sheepfold?

[Question] Who then, must all enter through, to give the great shepherd of the sheep acceptable godly service?

- 2· Because **through** him we, both peoples, have the approach to the Father by one spirit. (**Ephesians 2:18**)

[Question] What did the apostle Paul show was the tie that binds both Jews and Gentile anointed Christians together, into one flock of sheeplike ones?

- 3· He said to him the third time; Simon son of John, do you have affection for me? Peter became grieved that he said to him the third time; Do you have affection for me? So he said to him; Lord, you know all things. You are aware that I have affection for you. Jesus said to him; Feed my little sheep. (**John 21:17**)

[Question] What did Jesus three times tell Peter to put foremost, if he truly loved Jesus, and how should Peter treat the flock?

- 4· And the entrance of the innermost room he made with **doors** of oil-tree wood, side pillars, doorposts and a fifth. (**1 Kings 6:31**)

[Question] What was there at the temple entrance, and what was it made of?

- 5· But he that **enters through** the **door**, is shepherd of the sheep. (**John 10:2**)

[Question] Who is the one that enters through the door of the sheepfold?

- 6· Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except **through** me. (**John 14:6**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples about himself, and what he was?

[Question] Can anyone come to Yehowah God and do acceptable godly service before him, without coming through Jesus Christ?

7· Through whom also, we have gained our approach by faith, into this undeserved kindness, in which we now stand, and let us exult, based on hope of the glory of God. (Romans 5:2)

[Question] Where do anointed Christians stand, and how did they get there?
