

**John 11:1~** Now there was a certain man sick, Lazarus<sup>1</sup> of Bethany, of the village of Mary and of Martha her sister.

Footnote: Lazarus !ABJ17; J7-14, 16, 18, 19, 22, Eleazar meaning God Has Helped

**1·** Now there was a certain man who got sick, one Lazarus of Bethany, near to Jerusalem, who lived with his sisters Martha and Mary there in Bethany.

[Question] Who then got sick, and who were the sisters of this man Jesus knew and was friends with?

**2·** Now as they were going their way he entered into a certain village. Here a certain woman named Martha received him as guest into the house. (Luke 10:38)

[Question] Who earlier received Jesus into her house?

**3·** And leaving them behind he went outside the city to Bethany and passed the night there. (Matthew 21:17)

[Question] Where did Jesus also spend the night, on some occasions, when visiting Jerusalem?

**4·** Accordingly Jesus, six days before the Passover, arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus was whom Jesus had raised up from the dead. (John 12:1)

[Question] Where did Jesus first go, upon arriving in Jerusalem, on his final journey there, and who lived in this village?

**5·** Accordingly, the crowd that was with him when he called Lazarus out of the memorial tomb, and raised him up from the dead, kept bearing witness. (John 12:17)

[Question] Who later bore witness widely in nearby Jerusalem to the resurrection Jesus had performed of Lazarus?
