

John 11:10~ **But if anyone walks in the night, he bumps against something, because the light is not in him.**

1· So he said, that if anyone walks in the night, he will bump against something, because the light of this world is not in him.

[Question] What often happens to people walking about in the darkness, for what is not within them?

2· Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light, and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)

[Question] Who will experience woes, and why?

3· Jesus therefore said to them; The light will be among you a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, so that darkness does not overpower you, and he that walks in the darkness does not know where he is going. (John 12:35)

[Question] What did Jesus encourage his disciples to do while the light of God was with them, for what happens to those walking in the darkness?

4· But he that hates his brother is in the darkness, and is walking in the darkness, and he does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes. (1 John 2:11)

[Question] Where is the one hating his brother walking, for what has blinded his eyes?

5· But if your eye is wicked, your whole body will be dark. If in reality, the light that is in you is darkness, how great that darkness is! (Matthew 6:23)

[Question] What will become of anyone's body, if his eye is wicked?
