

John 11:16~ Therefore Thomas, who was called The Twin,¹ said to his fellow disciples; Let us also go, that we may die with him.

1· Therefore Thomas, the Twin, said to his fellow disciples; Let us go that we may die with him.

[Question] What did Thomas then say, showing that he too was not fearful of what the Jews might do to them?

2· The **disciples said** to him; Rabbi, just lately the Judeans were seeking to stone you, and are you going there again? (**John 11:8**)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples say to Jesus, when he showed that he was about to go into Judea again?

3· Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. (**Matthew 10:3**)

[Question] Who are six of Jesus' apostles?

4· And Matthew and Thomas, and James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon who is **called the zealous one**. (**Luke 6:15**)

[Question] Who are four of Jesus' apostles?

5· Thomas **said** to him; Lord, we do not know where you are going. How do we know the way? (**John 14:5**)

[Question] What did Thomas ask of Jesus on another occasion?

6· But Thomas, one of the twelve, who was **called, The Twin**, was not with them when Jesus came. (**John 20:24**)

[Question] What was Thomas also known as?

7· There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was **called The Twin**, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his **disciples**. (**John 21:2**)

[Question] How was Thomas also known, though his twin brother was not one of the apostles?
