John 11:17~ Consequently when Jesus arrived, he found he had already been four days in the memorial tomb.

1. So they journeyed to Bethany outside of Jerusalem, and upon arriving they found that Lazarus had already been dead for four days, and had thus been buried in a memorial tomb cut into the rock mass.

[Question] What then, did Jesus find when he arrived in Bethany, where Lazarus lived with his two sisters?

When he got to the other side, into the country of the Gadarenes, there met him two demon-possessed men coming out from among the memorial tombs, unusually fierce, so that nobody had the courage to pass by on that road. (Matthew 8:28)

[Question] Who did Jesus encounter in another occasion while among the memorial tombs?

3. Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice (John 5:28)

[Question] What hour did Jesus state was coming, and who would then hear his voice?

4. Therefore the Jews that were with her in the house, and that were consoling her, on seeing Mary rise quickly and go out, followed her, supposing that she was going to the memorial tomb to weep there. (John 11:31)

[Question] Who followed Mary to the gravesite of her brother upon seeing her leave the house, where they were mourning?
