1• Now the village of Bethany was near to Jerusalem, being a journey of about two miles.

2. Now when they were getting near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he dispatched two of his disciples (Mark 11:1)

[Question] What towns were situated on the Mount of Olives near to Jerusalem?

3. Then they returned to Jerusalem from a mountain called the Mount of Olives, which is near Jerusalem, being a Sabbath day's journey away. (Acts of Apostles 1:12)

[Question] How far away was Jerusalem from Bethany, and how is this distance expressed?
