1· So Martha upon greeting the Lord said, that if only he had been there, when Lazarus got sick, he would not have died. Thus though feeling, that there was now nothing Jesus could do, still, she expressed faith that he could have helped, if he had known.

[Question] How then, was she feeling, because her brother had been dead or four days?

2· And so Mary, when she arrived where Jesus was, and caught sight of him, fell at his feet, saying to him; Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died. (**John 11:32**)
