Therefore the Jews that were with her in the house, and that were consoling her, on seeing Mary rise quickly and go out, followed her, supposing that she was going to the memorial tomb to weep there.

1. So many of the Jews that were with her in the house, on seeing her get up and leave, followed after her, and came to where Jesus was. They were supposing that she was journeying to the memorial tomb to weep there.

[Question] Who then, saw Mary arise, and what did they also do, for what did they think that she was about to do?

2. Accordingly many of the Jews had come to Martha and Mary in order to console them concerning their brother. (John 11:19)

[Question] Who then, was there at the tomb of Lazarus, to witness this miracle of Lazarus' resurrection?

3. Consequently when Jesus arrived, he found he had already been four days in the memorial tomb. (John 11:17)

[Question] What then, was the situation surrounding the death of Lazarus, when Jesus arrived in Bethany?
